To Form A Chapter

Talk with several interested Master Masons in your area who ride motorcycles of 350cc or larger. See if there is enough interest to form a chapter. Have an organizational meeting to discuss the possibilities of forming a Chapter. If there is, choose or elect a core of officers to conduct the business of the chapter. The officers should include a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Road Captain, to co-ordinate rides and activities with Road Guards to assist him.

The Charter fee is \$100.00. Recruit as many members as possible, the more there are the less cost per member. A chapter may have any number of members. Collect dues from each member and divide the amount needed to Charter the Chapter plus a little extra for mailing chapter correspondence. Complete the Chapter application and mail it with the proper fee to the Membership Chairman of International. Remember to keep copies of any information you may send for your Chapter's history.

Once your application has been received it will be voted on at the next quarterly business meeting. After your Chapter application has been accepted, we will furnish you an informational packet to help get your Chapter off on the right foot.

Start planning rides, meetings, social functions, etc. You may want to consider incorporating your Chapter to protect your Officers and start thinking of ways to help sustain your Chapter financially. The Masonic Motorcycle Club International is both incorporated and a non-profit organization.

Your Secretary should maintain good records and a history of your Chapter. It is suggested that a monthly newsletter be sent to all your members to keep them informed of your Chapter's progress.

There is a lot more details to cover that will be in your organizational package.
